Agreement Regarding Private Reprimand/Supervision

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Marriage and Family Therapy Licensure Board (the "Board") is authorized by North Carolina General Statute 90-270.51(a) to enforce the provisions of the Marriage and Family Therapy Licensure Act (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, Heather Dunleavy ("the Licensee") is a "Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist" ("LMFT") pursuant to the Act, having license number 1930, issued February 15, 2018; and

WHEREAS, a complaint was filed against the Licensee on April 16, 2024, arising out of the Licensee's lack of clarity regarding the provision by her practice of both therapy and coaching services; and

WHEREAS, the Board and the Licensee agree to this private reprimand and that the Licensee would benefit from a period of supervision of her practice;

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED THAT: The licensee's practice will be supervised for a period of one year. For the first six months, there will be two supervision sessions per month. For the second six months, there will be one per month. It is further agreed that the supervisor will make at least three on-site visits during the

one-year period. The supervisor will be selected by mutual agreement between the Board and the Licensee.

This agreement is subject to Board approval and becomes effective upon Board approval and signature by its Chair.
